April 22 is a momentous date in the history of mankind. On this day there was born Vladimir Ilyich Lenin, the brilliant continuer of the immortal cause of Marx and Engels, the leader of all the oppressed and exploited, founder of the Bolshevik Party, organiser and leader of the Great October Socialist Revolution and founder of the first socialist state in the world.

Marx and Engels gave mankind a precise, scientifically based theory for the liberation of the working masses from the shackles of capitalism, from the yoke of exploitation, poverty and lack of rights. This theory is scientific Socialism. Marx and Engels indicated to the proletariat its historical mission as the grave-digger of the bourgeois regime, pointed to the socialist revolution as the sole path for the overthrow of the rule of the exploiters and for establishing the dictatorship of the proletariat.

As a result of historical conditions Russia became the focal point of all the contradictions of imperialism; the greatest popular revolution, headed by the most revolutionary proletariat in the world, was maturing in Russia, and Russia became the hearth of Leninism, the homeland of Leninism.

The great service rendered by Lenin was that he not only upheld Marxism against distortion by the reformist leaders of the Second International and opportunists of all hues, he creatively developed Marxism in conformity with the new historical conditions of the epoch of imperialism and proletarian revolutions, enriched it with fresh experience of the revolutionary struggle and raised it to a new, higher level. Together with Lenin, the struggle for the purity of Marxism, for the triumph of its ideas, was tirelessly waged and is waged now by Comrade Stalin whose works are an invaluable contribution to the treasury of Marxism-Leninism. Day by day the inextinguishable ideas of Leninism, brilliantly developed by Comrade Stalin-the great continuer of Lenin's cause-become the property of increasingly wider masses in all countries and exert an ever greater influence on the entire course of world history.

Lenin and Stalin raised to unprecedented heights the significance of revolutionary theory, taught Communists in all countries to make full use of its mobilising, organising and transforming power. vanguard of the proletariat.

Lenin and Stalin teach us that the Party is the supreme form of the class organisation of the proletariat, its advanced, conscious and organised detachment, cemented by unity of will, action and discipline, armed with the all-conquering Marxist theory and indissolubly linked with the working-class masses. With what force the weighty words spoken by Lenin in 1920 sound now that the "Russian model shows something to all countries, and something very substantial, from their inevitable and near future!"

Constantly consolidating its ranks, the Socialist Unity Party of Germany, based on the principles of Marxism-Leninism, now heading the struggle of the German people for the speedy conclusion of a peace treaty, for uniting all German people into a single, independent, peace-loving, democratic Germany, is confidently marching along the pathway of becoming a Party of a new type.
